Construction Update

Steels Heating and Air started work on the Sanctuary HVAC system on January 2nd. Newton Construction started work on the choir loft and painting on January 16th. The choir loft area has been gutted and the pews, flooring and carpet have been removed. The pews have been given to an organization that will distribute them to needy churches.

The Worship Unit Subcommittee working with the Church consultant has chosen the paint colors, types of pews, flooring and carpet.

The Enabling Unit Subcommittee is working with several local banks on securing the necessary funds to finance the entire project; however, no debt will be incurred until such time as approved by the congregation.

These are exciting times in the life of First Presbyterian Church. There is an urge to go into the Sanctuary to see the progress of this work. You are cautioned that this is a construction area, thus proceed with the utmost caution.
