## Sanctuary

We are excited to announce that Steeles Heating and Air of Lancaster, SC has been contracted to install the new HVAC system in the Sanctuary building. This system includes a four stage air chiller and a two stage gas boiler as well as new air handlers, duct work, pumps, etc. It will provide us with very efficient and effective temperature and humidity control at a reduced utility cost for many years.

One item necessary for this efficient performance is to remove the oak tree behind the Sanctuary building that overhangs the air chiller area. Arrangements have been made to save sections of this tree for use by any interested wood worker. If you are interested in securing some of this wood, please contact Rudy Lee in the church office.

Installation of the new HVAC system will start the first week in January. The renovation of the Choir loft will follow soon thereafter. We hope to have all of the Sanctuary renovation work completed by Easter. During this construction period, Church Worship Services will be held in the CLC starting on Sunday, January 8, 2012.
